Personal and socio-economic characteristics of sugarcane growers of Belagavi and Bagalkote district of Karnataka

Received: 06.09.2019; Revised: 08.10.2019; Accepted: 15.10.2019 **SUMMARY:** The present study was conducted in Belagavi and Bagalkote district in north Karnataka during the year 2018-19 with the objectives to asses the personal and socio-economic characteristics of sugarcane growers. *Ex-post-facto* research design was undertaken for the present study. The findings of the study revealed that majority of the respondents belonged to middle age category (63.33%), medium family size (53.33%), medium family size (53.33%), medium farming experience (46.66%), high comsmopolitenes (40.83%), medium extension contact (50.00%) and 72.50 per cent of respondents were cultivating maize in *Kharif* season along with the sugarcane.
